DEFICIENCY LIST

- 1. ALL SLEEPING ROOM DISCONTINUE UNSAFE COOKING MN Rules 1300.0180 Immediately discontinue use of unsafe heating appliance in all sleeping rooms.-Discontinue using cooking appliance and coffee makers in sleeping rooms.
- 2. ANNUAL FIRE ALARM MAINTENANCE PROVIDE DOCUMENTATION MSFC 907.20 as amended Provide required annual maintenance of the fire alarm system by a qualified person and provide written documentation to this office as proof of compliance.
- 3. CLOSET LIGHT FIXTURES REPLACE GLOBES MSFC 605.1- All light fixtures shall be maintained with protective globes if originally equipped.-Replace all missing closet globes.
- 4. *SLEEPING ROOMS OPENABLE DIMENTIONS MSFC1026.1 Provide and maintain an approved escape window from each sleeping room. The minimum size must be 5 square feet of glazed area with a minimum of 24 inches of openable height and 20 inches of openable width. With a finished sill height not more than 48 inches. This work may require permit(s). Call DSI at (651) 266-9090. Refer to the Escape Windows for Residential Occupancies handout for more information.-Open dimension of the first floor north and east bedrooms are 22 inches high by 24 inches wide. The second floor staff bedroom measures 19 inches high by 24 inches wide. The second floor north bedroom measures 18 inches wide by 18 inches high.
- 5. WATER HEATER ADJUST TEMPERATURE SPLC 34.11 (6) Provide and maintain a hot water temperature of 120 degrees F at all times.
