Re: Repurchase application relating to a tax-forfeited property at 1115 Ross Avenue

Dear Marcia Moermond:

Enclosed please find a repurchase application received from John E. Burdine for the property located at 1115 Ross Avenue. The property forfeited to the State of Minnesota on August 1, 2012 and is an occupied single-family house. The prior owner of the property, John E. Burdine, is the repurchase applicant and recently deceased. Presently his children occupy the property through a lease agreement with the county. Please review the attached statement regarding the circumstances that led to the forfeiture as part of the repurchase application. The amount of delinquent taxes owed on the property at the time of forfeiture was \$7,500.60.

County Board policy, No. 99-507, adopted on December 21, 1999, allows for "each repurchase application to be referred to the municipality in which the property is located. The municipality will document whether the property is considered a municipal problem based on documented police, building code, illegal activity, or health violations within the past five years. The municipality, by resolution, shall recommend that the County Board approve or deny the repurchase application and return the repurchase application to Ramsey County along with the resolution and documentation of any violations."
