Revocation of Fire Certificate of Occupancy and Order to Vacate

RE: 1810 MONTANA AVE E

Dear Property Representative:

Your building was determined to be a registered vacant building on June 6, 2013. Since certificates are for the occupancy of buildings, it has become necessary to revoke the Certificate of Occupancy.

Saint Paul Legislative Code provides that no building shall be occupied without a Certificate of Occupancy. In order to re-occupy the building, the following deficiencies (if applicable) must be corrected and a complete Certificate of Occupancy inspection will be required.

DEFICIENCY LIST

- 1. Bedrooms west and south sides SPLC 34.10 (7), 34.33 (6) Repair and maintain the ceiling in an approved manner.-Repair or replace the damaged or deteriorated ceiling. Paint the ceiling. Patch the holes and/or cracks in the ceiling.
- 2. SPLC 34.09 (1) e, 34.32 (1) d Provide and maintained the roof weather tight and free from defects.
- 3. SPLC 34.09 (2) 34.32 (2) Provide an approved guardrail with intermediate ballustrade or rails 4 inches or less apart. This work will require a permit(s). Call DSI at (651) 266-9090.-Guardrails attached to the house steps are strapped together with rubber. Repair or replace to code.
- 4. SPLC 200.02 (a) No person shall own, harbor, keep or maintain in the City and dog over three months of age without a license. Provide written documentation of current license to the Fire Inspector. To obtain a dog license, contact DSI at 651-266-8989

- 5. UMC 504.6 Provide, repair or replace the dryer exhaust duct. Exhaust ducts for domestic clothes dryers shall be constructed of metal and shall have a smooth interior finish. The exhaust duct shall be a minimum nominal size of four inches (102 mm) in diameter. This work will require a permit(s). Call DSI at (651) 266-8989.
- 6. SPLC 34.10 (1) Abate and maintain the basement reasonably free from dampness and free of mold and mildew.
- 7. MN Stat. 299F.362 Immediately provide and maintain a smoke detector located outside each sleeping area.-smoke detector hanging off the wall. Mount the smoke detector so it is operational. Hallway downstairs bedrooms.
- 8. SPLC 34.11 (6), 34.34 (3) Provide service of heating facility by a licensed contractor which must include a carbon monoxide test. Submit a completed copy of the Saint Paul Fire Marshal's Existing Fuel Burning Equipment Safety Test Report to this office.
- 9. SPLC 39.02(c) Complete and sign the smoke detector affidavit and return it to this office.

You have the right to appeal these orders to the Legislative Hearing Officer.
