Your building was inspected on February 12, 2013 for the renewal of your Fire Certificate of Occupancy. Approval for occupancy will be granted upon compliance with the following deficiency list. The items on the list must be corrected prior to the re-inspection date.

A re-inspection will be made on May 6, 2013 at 2:30 PM.

Failure to comply may result in a criminal citation or the revocation of the Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The Saint Paul Legislative Code requires that no building shall be occupied without a Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The code also provides for the assessment of additional reinspection fees.

YOU WILL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR NOTIFYING TENANTS IF ANY OF THE FOLLOWING LIST OF DEFICIENCIES ARE THEIR RESPONSIBILITY.

DEFICIENCY LIST

- 1. <u>Exterior Rear Porch MSFC 605.1</u> Repair or replace damaged electrical fixtures. This work may require a permit(s). Call DSI at (651) 266-9090.
- 2. <u>Interior 2nd Floor SPLC 34.10 (4), 34.33 (3)</u> Caulk bathtub seams to provide a bathroom floor impervious to water.
- 3. <u>Interior Basement NEC 110-26</u> Provide and maintain a minimum of 36 inches clearance in front of all electrical panels.

- 4. <u>Interior Basement MSFC 605.1</u>- All light fixtures shall be maintained with protective globes if originally equipped.
- 5. <u>Interior Basement SPLC 34.10 (7), 34.33 (6)</u> Repair and maintain the walls in an approved manner.
- 6. <u>Interior Basement MSMC 504.6</u> Provide, repair or replace the dryer exhaust duct. Exhaust ducts for domestic clothes dryers shall be constructed of metal and shall have a smooth interior finish. The exhaust duct shall be a minimum nominal size of four inches (102 mm) in diameter. This work may require a permit(s). Call DSI at (651) 266-8989.
- 7. <u>Interior Kitchen SPLC 34.10 (7), 34.33 (6)</u> Repair and maintain the cabinets in an approved manner.
- 8. <u>Interior MN State Statute 299F.50</u> Immediately provide and maintain an approved Carbon Monoxide Alarm in a location within ten (10) feet of each sleeping area. Installation shall be in accordance with manufacturers instructions.
- 9. <u>SPLC 34.11 (6), 34.34 (3)</u> Provide service of heating facility by a licensed contractor which must include a carbon monoxide test. Submit a completed copy of the Saint Paul Fire Marshal's Existing Fuel Burning Equipment Safety Test Report to this office.
- 10. <u>SPLC 39.02(c)</u> Complete and sign the smoke detector affidavit and return it to this office.
