On 03/26/2013 at 0551 hours, we (SQD 113--Officers Kasal and Gliske) were sent to 1818 Minnehaha Ave. W. on a Suspicious call. The complainant, a passerby, was no longer on scene.

Upon arrival, we saw that the front window to the grocery store had been broken out and merchandise was on the ground outside the store. The store was very small and it appeared that we could see most, if not all, of the interior of the store from outside. It appeared that nobody was inside the store. We were unable to gain entry into the store, as the door was still locked and it would've been extremely unsafe to enter the business through the window, since there were large shards of glass hanging from the window frame.

We called for a keyholder to respond to the scene, but dispatch notified us that none was available. We looked up the address in RMS and tried calling several numbers associated with the business. We did not locate a keyholder,

We asked DATA to call for a boardup crew to secure the business. We placed a green inventory sheet inside the window with the case number on it
