### NOTICE OF CONDEMNATION AS UNFIT FOR HUMAN HABITATION AND ORDER TO VACATE

Damon Haywood 163 Acker St E St Paul MN 55117-5511

Dear Sir or Madam:

The Department of Safety and Inspections, Division of Code Enforcement, has determined that the dwelling and premises at 163 ACKER ST E is "Unfit for Human Habitation". In accordance with Saint Paul Legislative Code, Chapter 34, Section 23, the premises will be placarded on July 3, 2013 and ordered vacated no later than July 3, 2013

Your attention is called to the following provisions of Section 34.23, Subsection 6 entitled, "Vacation of Structure or Unit":

"Any residential structure or residential unit which has been condemned or placarded as unfit for human habitation shall be vacated within the time set forth in the placard and/or order. It shall be unlawful for any person to let to any person for human habitation any structure or unit so condemned or placarded, and no person shall occupy the structure or unit after the date set forth in the placard and/or notice."

THIS DWELLING SHALL NOT AGAIN BE USED FOR HUMAN HABITATION UNTIL WRITTEN APPROVAL IS SECURED FROM THE CITY OF SAINT PAUL; DEPARTMENT OF SAFETY AND INSPECTIONS, DIVISION OF CODE ENFORCEMENT

<u>Principle Violations</u>: These deficiencies must be corrected before this condemnation and vacate order will be removed.

- 1. THERE IS A DEFECTIVE SEWER LINE WHICH IS BROKEN AND SEWAGE IS DISCHARGEING INTO STREET.CONTACT LORI LEMKE WITH SEWER DEPARTMENT AT 651-266-6230 TO OBTAIN A LISAT OF CONTRACTORS TO REPLACE LINE OR USE CITY SEWER ASSEMENT PROGRAM, DISCONTINUE USING WATER AT THIS TIME.
- 2. <u>Other Violations</u>: These deficiencies must be corrected in order to bring this property into compliance with the Saint Paul Legislative Code.

Authorization to reoccupy this/these dwelling unit(s) will not be given until it is demonstrated that all principal violations have been corrected and that no new conditions exist which could constitute material endangerment or which threaten the peace, health, safety or welfare of the occupants of this building.

All repairs and new installations must be made in accordance with the appropriate codes. Permit information may be obtained from the Building Inspection and Design Section, 375 Jackson Street, Suite 220, (651) 266-8989.

You may file an appeal to this notice by contacting the City Clerk's Office at (651) 266-8688. Any appeal must be made in writing within 10 days of the date of this notice.

It is the responsibility of the property owner to keep all buildings secured and to properly maintain the premises at all times.



Hi Barbara,

When your plumber got their plumbing instruments stuck in your sewer line, a Sewer Maintenance crew televised the main sewer to see if their instrument was in the main. I attached a picture of your sewer connection to the City main. Your connection is heavy, full of roots. They did not make it through the root mass with their instrument. I attached a picture of your sewer connection. This large root mass is what is causing your sewer back up.
