- -Feb 25 police were called at 12 midnight to secure 1 door, 5 windows and 1 opening with 2 clips to 171 Arch St, apartment B for a cost of \$345
- has no police report

#### Mr. LaBelle:

- -also, does not have a copy of the police report but the police were looking for a suspect and kicked-in the back door of this unit instead of their usual procedure of calling us (we have people who work through the night to take care of these kinds of problems)
- -he was surprised when he saw this invoice on his desk
- -he tried to figure out which property they were assessing; after talking to many people, he was able to figure it out
- -99% of the time, the police call them and they come out to secure the property themselves
- -the police know that this property belongs to them

### Ms. Seeley:

-apparently, they needed to get someone right there and then, especially, if it's in public housing -we really need to see the police report

## Ms. Moermond:
