An inspection was made of your building on July 2, 2013 in response to a referral. You are hereby notified that the following deficiency list must be corrected immediately. A reinspection will be made on July 23, 2013 at 1:30pm.

Failure to comply may result in a criminal citation or revocation of the Certificate of Occupancy. The Saint Paul Legislative Code requires that no building shall be occupied without a Certificate of Occupancy. The code also provides for the assessment of additional reinspection fees.

DEFICIENCY LIST

- Exterior SPLC 34.09 (1) a, 34.32 (1) a Provide and maintain foundation elements to adequately support this building at all points.
- 2. Exterior SPLC 34.09 (1) e, 34.32 (1) d Provide and maintained the roof weather tight and free from defects.-Contact a licensed contractor to repair and replace the roof all work must be done under permit and approved.
- 3. Exterior SPLC 34.09 (1) b,c, 34.33 (1) b, c Provide and maintain all exterior walls free from holes and deterioration. All wood exterior unprotected surfaces must be painted or protected from the elements and maintained in a professional manner free from chipped or peeling paint.
- 4. Exterior SPLC 34.09 (3), 34.32 (3) Repair and maintain the window frame.
- 5. Exterior SPLC 34.09 (3), 34.32 (3) Repair and maintain the window glass.
- 6. Exterior SPLC 34.09 (3), 34.33 (3) -Provide or repair and maintain the window screen.
- 7. Exterior SPLC 45.03 (6) Cut and maintain the grass/weeds less than 8 inches tall.
- 8. Exterior SPLC 34.09 (2) 34.32 (2) Provide an approved handrail. The top of the handrail must be between 34 and 38 inches above the treads and run the entire length of the stair.

Exterior - SPLC 34.08 (1), 34.31 (1) - All exterior property areas shall be maintained free from any accumulation of refuse, garbage or feces.

Exterior - SPLC 34.08(5), 34.32(3) - All accessory structures including, but not limited to, detached garages, sheds, retaining walls and fences shall be maintained structurally sound and in good repair. Provide and maintain exterior unprotected surfaces painted or protected from the elements.-Repair or replace the retaining wall in an approved manner.

11. Throughout - SPLC 34.19 - Provide access to the inspector to all areas of the building for a full certificate of occupancy inspection 07/23/13 at 1:30pm.
