Dear Property Representative:

Your building was re-inspected for the Fire Certificate of Occupancy on July 26, 2013. Approval for occupancy will be granted upon compliance with the following deficiency list. The items on the list must be corrected immediately.

A reinspection will be made on August 30, 2013 at 1:30 PM.

Failure to comply may result in a criminal citation or the revocation of the Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The Saint Paul Legislative Code requires that no building be occupied without a Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The code also provides for the assessment of additional reinspection fees.

DEFICIENCY LIST

- 1. Exterior Ext. Door SPLC 34.09 (3), 34.33 (3) Repair and maintain the door in good condition. Repair or replace front screen door.
- Exterior SPLC 34.09-(2), 34.32(2) Repair or replace the unsafe stairways, porch, decks
 or railings in an approved manner. This work may require a permit(s). Call DSI at (651)
 266-9090. Repair or replace unsafe deck on North East side of house.
- 3. Exterior SPLC 34.09 (1) b,c, 34.33 (1) b, c Provide and maintain all exterior walls free from holes and deterioration. All wood exterior unprotected surfaces must be painted or protected from the elements and maintained in a professional manner free from chipped or peeling paint. Where chipped and peeling paint is occurring scrape and paint surfaces.
- 4. Exterior SPLC 71.01 The address posted is not visible from street. (HN-1) Provide address numbers that contrast with the background.

- 5. Main Floor West window SPLC 34.09 (3), 34.32 (3) Repair and maintain the window sash.
- 6. North Entryway SPLC 34.10 (7), 34.34 (6) Repair and maintain the walls in an approved manner. Patch the holes and/or cracks in the walls. Paint the wall.
- 7. North Entryway MSFC 1003.3.1.8 Remove unapproved locks from the exit doors. The door must be operable from the inside without the use of keys or special knowledge or effort.
- 8. SPLC 34.11 (6), 34.34 (3) Provide service of heating facility by a licensed contractor which must include a carbon monoxide test. Submit a completed copy of the Saint Paul Fire Marshal's Existing Fuel Burning Equipment Safety Test Report to this office.
- 9. SPLC 39.02(c) Complete and sign the smoke detector affidavit and return it to this office.

You have the right to appeal these orders to the Legislative Hearing Officer.
