Your building was inspected on May 10, 2013 for the renewal of your Fire Certificate of Occupancy. Approval for occupancy will be granted upon compliance with the following deficiency list. The items on the list must be corrected prior to the re-inspection date.

A re-inspection will be made on July 10, 2013 at 2:00 PM.

Failure to comply may result in a criminal citation or the revocation of the Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The Saint Paul Legislative Code requires that no building shall be occupied without a Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The code also provides for the assessment of additional reinspection fees.

YOU WILL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR NOTIFYING TENANTS IF ANY OF THE FOLLOWING LIST OF DEFICIENCIES ARE THEIR RESPONSIBILITY.

DEFICIENCY LIST

1. Exterior throughout. - SPLC 34.09 (2) 34.32 (2) - Provide an approved guardrail with intermediate balustrade or rails 4 inches or less apart. This work may require a permit(s). Call DSI at (651) 266-9090. -Repair or replace the stucco framing around the back stairs of the home.

Also seal all openings around the home in the stucco and brick to prevent water penetration.

Also cap off the vent on the East side of the building.

- 2. Exterior window frame. SPLC 34.09 (3), 34.32 (3) Repair and maintain the window in good condition. -Repair the wood under the window on the North side of the home next to the back stairs.
- 3. Interior front and back hallways. SPLC 34.10 (7), 34.34 (6) Repair and maintain the walls in an approved manner.
 - -Both the front and back hallways of the building need to be repainted. Also paint the inside and outside of both front doors of the home.

You have the right to appeal these orders to the Legislative Hearing Officer.
