Appeal For Property For Charles W. Belcher 863 Rose Avenue East St. Paul. MN 55106

Violation #1 - Chrysler, White, 997-PX, violations A, D, E

- A. The license tabs are expired. I will be renewing them within the next 3-4 weeks.
- D. This vehicle does run, however, someone has flattened the tires and I have not been able to replace. I have a torn rotary cuff in my shoulder and I have not been able to do the physical work that replacing the tires require.
- E. This actually is an official driveway which has been approved by the City of St. Paul. I applied for a permit to make this area a driveway years ago. At that time the city approved as a driveway. I also had Class 5 rock put in. Not to mention, the city did a sweep of my property about 3 years ago with some items that they wanted to be taken care of that I am still paying for. At that time the city said that my vehicles parked here are fine. I have been using this as parking for the last 8-10 years and it has never been an issue. Why the problem now? I am currently working to remove the weeds that are in the driveway and because of other health conditions I wasn't able to get to it earlier in the season like I usually do. If this is what the problem is, it is already being addressed.

Violation #2 - Commercial Truck, White, Y/AH6973

- A. The license tabs are expired. I will be renewing them within the next 3-4 weeks.

- F. I have used this truck for the last 8-10 years for my business to hall supplies for my business. This vehicle is no longer registered as a commercial vehicle. This year I have not used it like I have in the past due to the fact that I have not been able to work due as often due the injury with my shoulder and when I have worked I did not have to use this for supplies because the business has decreased about 50% and I have not used my 2nd cart. I will hopefully be using again when the business turns around.

Additional Factors:

I have had several health issues this year which has caused me not to be able to work. Because I am self-employed seasonally if I am not able to work I do not earn money. I am working to resolve these issues and I am requesting additional 1-2 months so I can get the funds together to take care of these items.
