Your building was inspected on September 20, 2013 in response to a referral. It has become necessary to conduct a full Fire Certificate of Occupancy inspection. Approval for occupancy will be granted upon compliance with the following deficiency list.

The items on the list must be corrected prior to the re-inspection date, failure to comply may result in criminal citation or revocation of the Fire Certificate of Occupancy.

A re-inspection will be made on October 3, 2013 at 2:30 PM.

The Saint Paul Legislative Code requires that no building shall be occupied without a Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The code also provides for the assessment of additional re-inspection fees.

YOU WILL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR NOTIFYING TENANTS IF ANY OF THE FOLLOWING LIST OF DEFICIENCIES ARE THEIR RESPONSIBILITY.

## **DEFICIENCY LIST**

1. Exterior - East Entry - SPLC 34.09 (2), 34.32(2) - Repair or replace the unsafe stairways, porch, decks or railings in an approved manner. This requires a permit(s). Call DSI at (651) 266-9090. - Repair or replace concrete limestone steps. THIS MUST BE COMPLETED BY NO LATER THAN OCTOBER 3, 2013, OR ENFORCEMENT ACTION MAY BE TAKEN.

- 2. Interior Entryway SPLC 34.10 (2), 34.33 Repair and maintain the structural elements to code. This repair requires a building permit, and approval from building inspector. Call DSI at (651) 266-9090. Have all building permits finalled and approved prior to inspection on 10/3/13. THIS MUST BE COMPLETED BY NO LATER THAN OCTOBER 3, 2013, OR ENFORCEMENT ACTION MAY BE TAKEN.
- 3. Interior Throughout SPLC 34.19 Provide access to the inspector to all areas of the building.
- 4. SPLC 34.11 (6), 34.34 (3) Provide service of heating facility by a licensed contractor which must include a carbon monoxide test. Submit a completed copy of the Saint Paul Fire Marshal's Existing Fuel Burning Equipment Safety Test Report to this office.
- 5. SPLC 39.02(c) Complete and sign the smoke detector affidavit and return it to this office.

You have the right to appeal these orders to the Legislative Hearing Officer.
