This is to confirm that our office has received your application for a variance from the city's noise ordinance and that it is being processed.

You requested a variance to allow you to have a DJ booth and sound system during your annual school fundraising event at 1031 Como Avenue, between 7:00 p.m. and 12:00 midnight on February 22, 2014. The recommendation is for a noise limit of 75 dBA as measured at a distance of 50 feet from the building exterior from 7:00 p.m. to 12:00 midnight.

A public hearing on your request for a variance has been scheduled for **December 4, 2013, 5:30 p.m.**, Third Floor, City Council Chambers, at the Saint Paul City Hall/Ramsey County Courthouse, 15 Kellogg Boulevard W., Saint Paul, Minnesota.

You may wish to be present at this hearing to answer any questions that the City Council might have. After the public hearing, the Council may grant, deny, or modify the variance request.
