Your building was inspected on October 28, 2013 for the renewal of your Fire Certificate of Occupancy. Approval for occupancy will be granted upon compliance with the following deficiency list. The items on the list must be corrected prior to the re-inspection date.

A re-inspection will be made on December 6, 2013 at 9:30 AM.

Failure to comply may result in a criminal citation or the revocation of the Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The Saint Paul Legislative Code requires that no building shall be occupied without a Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The code also provides for the assessment of additional reinspection fees.

YOU WILL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR NOTIFYING TENANTS IF ANY OF THE FOLLOWING LIST OF DEFICIENCIES ARE THEIR RESPONSIBILITY.

DEFICIENCY LIST

- 1. Basement Stairs SPLC 34.10 (3), 34.33(2) Repair or replace the unsafe stairway in an approved manner. This work will require a permit. Call 266-8989.
 - -Stairs are not uniform and the measurements do not meet code.

- 2. Bathroom Main Floor SPLC 34.11, MSBC 2902.1, SPLC 34.17, MSPC 415.0220 Repair or replace and maintain all parts of the plumbing system to an operational condition.
 - -Toilet is loose at the floor.
- 3. First Bedroom Main Floor MSFC 605.1- All light fixtures shall be maintained with protective globes if originally equipped.

 -Child bedroom.
- 4. Garage Alley Side SPLC 71.01 The address posted is not visible from street. -Provide address numbers that contrast with the background.
- 5. Kitchen Main Floor NEC 440.13 For cord-connected equipment such as room air conditioners, household refrigerators and freezers, drinking water coolers, and beverage dispensers, a separable connector or an attachment plug and receptable shall be permitted to serve as the disconnecting means. The appliance must plug directly into a permanent outlet.
 - -Refrigerator and oven range.
- 6. Kitchen Main Floor MSFC 605.4 Discontinue use of all multi-plug adapters.-Fridge and oven range.
- 7. Second floor Master Bedroom MSFC 1003.3.1.8 Remove unapproved locks from the unit doors. The door must be openable from the inside without the use of keys or special knowledge or effort.

 -Bedroom door.
