On 07/02/2013 at 0216 hours, Squad 212 (LOKHORST/SANDELL) was dispatched to 784 Capitol Heights on a Burglary Alarm covering back door. The alarm was reported by the alarm company, VIVINT (877-320-2706).

We responded to the scene and found a broken window with a cut screen in the rear of the house at the northeast corner. The back door was partially open. We aired this information and requested additional squads to our location. While waiting for additional squads, we covered the 2-3 (northeast) and 1-4 (southwest) corners while waiting for additional squads.

When additional squads and canine arrived, officers at the front attempted to knock and make contact with anyone inside. No one came to the front door, so officers went to the back door and made several announcements into the residence without success. Officers then cleared the residence and discovered no one inside.

Inside, we could not find any evidence of property taken from the residence. Ammunition for a .40 caliber handgun and 12 gauge shotgun was found in an upstairs bedroom but no firearms were located.

Dispatch could not contact a keyholder through the alarm company and no additional phone numbers were located for the residents. We could not locate any phone numbers inside the house. A vacation packing list was located on the kitchen counter.

Squad 219 took photos of the damage to the window. See supplement.

Squad 211T processed several fingerprints at the scene. See supplement.

Board up crew was requested to the scene and secured the residence.

A business card containing the case number was left at the residence.
