Your building was inspected on June 21, 2012 for the renewal of your Fire Certificate of Occupancy. Approval for occupancy will be granted upon compliance with the following deficiency list. The items on the list must be corrected prior to the re-inspection date. A reinspection will be made on July 23, 2012 at after 9:30 am.

Failure to comply may result in a criminal citation or the revocation of the Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The Saint Paul Legislative Code requires that no building shall be occupied without a Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The code also provides for the assessment of additional reinspection fees.

YOU WILL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR NOTIFYING TENANTS IF ANY OF THE FOLLOWING LIST OF DEFICIENCIES ARE THEIR RESPONSIBILITY.

DEFICIENCY LIST

1. Sleeping Rooms - Egress Windows - MSFC1026.1 - Provide and maintain an approved escape window from each sleeping room. The minimum size must be 5 square feet of glazed area with a minimum of 24 inches of openable height and 20 inches of openable width. With a finished sill height not more than 48 inches. This work may require permit(s). Call DSI at (651) - 266-9090. Refer to the Escape Windows for Residential Occupanices handout for more information.

-Main Floor Southeast Bedroom East Window 20 w x 20.25 h openable 18 w x 40.50 h glazed Main Floor Northeast Bedroom East Window 23.50 w x 21.25 h openable 21.50 w x 42.50 h glazed

Main Floor Northeast Bedroom North Window 22 w x 20 h openable 20 w x 40 h glazed

2nd Floor North Casement Window 18 w x 36 h openable

*Note a time of inspection 2nd Floor North Casement Window crank is damaged. Casement window on order.
