The Macalester-Groveland Community Council's Organics Steering Committee met on January 23, 2014 to discuss the City's plans to amend its Zoning Code around collection of source-separated organics (SSO). The Committee passed the following recommendation, which was then approved by the Community Council's Executive Committee on February 3, 2014.

The Macalester-Groveland Community Council supports the City of Saint Paul's draft Zoning Code amendments pertaining to source-separated organics.

The Community Council welcomes Ramsey County's plans to collect SSO at each of its seven Yard Waste Sites. Our organization has operated a successful community organics drop-off since June 2012 and has seen first-hand that the demand for convenient, low-cost organics collection services is high among Saint Paul residents. Well-managed organics recycling drop-off sites are free of issues like odors and are an asset to the community.
