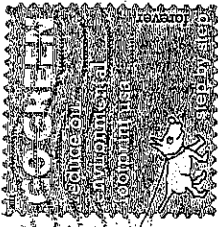
Please support this change of the existing zoning code regarding waste collection at yard waste sites for the sake of our planet.

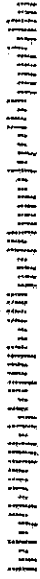
