Your building was inspected on January 30, 2014 for the renewal of your Fire Certificate of Occupancy. Approval for occupancy will be granted upon compliance with the following deficiency list. The items on the list must be corrected prior to the re-inspection date. A reinspection will be made on February 27, 2014 at 1:15 pm.

Failure to comply may result in a criminal citation or the revocation of the Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The Saint Paul Legislative Code requires that no building shall be occupied without a Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The code also provides for the assessment of additional reinspection fees.

YOU WILL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR NOTIFYING TENANTS IF ANY OF THE FOLLOWING LIST OF DEFICIENCIES ARE THEIR RESPONSIBILITY.

DEFICIENCY LIST

- 1. 1836 Basement MSFC 605.5 Discontinue use of extension cords used in lieu of permanent wiring.-Power strip on extension cord. Power strip must be plugged directly into wall outlet.
- 2. 1836 Basement MSMC 504.6 Provide, repair or replace the dryer exhaust duct. Exhaust ducts for domestic clothes dryers shall be constructed of metal and shall have a smooth

interior finish. The exhaust duct shall be a minimum nominal size of four inches (102 mm) in diameter and installed in accordance with the mechanical code.-Repair dryer vent

- 3. 1836 Bath SPLC 34.10 (7), 34.34 (6) Repair and maintain the ceiling in an approved manner.-Patch the holes and/or cracks in the ceiling. Paint the ceiling.
- 4. 1838 Basement MSMC 504.6 Provide, repair or replace the dryer exhaust duct. Exhaust ducts for domestic clothes dryers shall be constructed of metal and shall have a smooth interior finish. The exhaust duct shall be a minimum nominal size of four inches (102 mm) in diameter and installed in accordance with the mechanical code. This work will require a permit(s). Call DSI at (651) 266-8989.-REQUIRES A LICENSED CONTRACTOR UNDER PERMIT AND INSPECTION BY WARM AIR / VENT INSPECTOR CALL JON 266-9062
- 5. SPLC 34.11 (6), 34.34 (3) Provide service of heating facility by a licensed contractor which must include a carbon monoxide test. Submit a completed copy of the Saint Paul Fire Marshal's Existing Fuel Burning Equipment Safety Test Report to this office.
