Your building was inspected on January 27, 2011 for the renewal of your Fire Certificate of Occupancy. Approval for occupancy will be granted upon compliance with the following deficiency list. The items on the list must be corrected prior to the re-inspection date. A re-inspection will be made after February 28, 2011.

Failure to comply may result in a criminal citation or the revocation of the Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The Saint Paul Legislative Code requires that no building shall be occupied without a Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The code also provides for the assessment of additional re-inspection fees.

YOU WILL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR NOTIFYING TENANTS IF ANY OF THE FOLLOWING LIST OF DEFICIENCIES ARE THEIR RESPONSIBILITY.

- 2. DAYCARE MN Stat 299F.30 Conduct 5 fire drills per year. Maintain documents showing the date and time required to evacuate the building.
- 3. FELLOWSHIP HALL MSFC 1010.5, SPLC 34.14 (2) d, SPLC 34.34 (5) b Provide and maintain illumination in all portions of the exit system.-REPAIR EMERGENCY LIGHTING

- 4. FURNACE ROOM MSFC 1010.1, 1003.3.1.8 Remove all locks in excess of 1-REMOVE SLIDE BOLT
- 5. FUNACE ROOM UMC 1346.703 Provide 30 inches clearance around all mechanical equipment.
- 6. KITCHEN MSFC 1010.3 Provide and maintain approved external or internal lighting of the exit sign.
- 7. SECOND FLOOR A/C MSFC 605.5 Discontinue use of extension cords used in lieu of permanent wiring.
