#### FIRE INSPECTION CORRECTION NOTICE

### Dear Property Representative:

Your building was inspected on February 7, 2014 for the renewal of your Fire Certificate of Occupancy. Approval for occupancy will be granted upon compliance with the following deficiency list. The items on the list must be corrected prior to the re-inspection date. A reinspection will be made on March 11, 2014 at 1:30 PM.

Failure to comply may result in a criminal citation or the revocation of the Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The Saint Paul Legislative Code requires that no building shall be occupied without a Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The code also provides for the assessment of additional reinspection fees.

YOU WILL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR NOTIFYING TENANTS IF ANY OF THE FOLLOWING LIST OF DEFICIENCIES ARE THEIR RESPONSIBILITY.

#### **DEFICIENCY LIST**

- 1. EXTERIOR-ALLEY SIDE SPLC 71.01 Provide address numbers on building.-Provide address numbers atleast 4 inches in size that contrast with the background.
- 2. EXTERIOR-STREET SIDE SPLC 71.01 Provide address numbers on building.-Provide address numbers at least 4 inches in size that contrast with the background. The present numbers are not easily visible from the street.

- 3. INTERIOR-THROUGHOUT MSFC 901.6 Provide required annual maintenance of the fire extinguishers by a qualified person and tag the fire extinguishers with the date of service.-Service all three fire extinguishers.
- 4. MAIN LEVEL-ABOVE DOOR LEADING TO THE GARAGE MSFC 1010.3 Provide and maintain approved external or internal lighting of the exit sign.-Remove the EXIT sign.
- 5. MAIN LEVEL-DOOR LEADING TO THE GARAGE MSFC 1008.1.8.1, 1028.2 Remove unapproved locks from the exit doors. The door must be openable from the inside without the use of keys or special knowledge or effort.-Remove the dead bolt lock. Door from the garage cannot be locked from the non-egress side.

You have the right to appeal these orders to the Legislative Hearing Officer.
