Your building was inspected on February 13, 2014 for the renewal of your Fire Certificate of Occupancy. Approval for occupancy will be granted upon compliance with the following deficiency list. The items on the list must be corrected prior to the re-inspection date.

### A re-inspection will be made on March 13, 2014 at 1:30 AM.

Failure to comply may result in a criminal citation or the revocation of the Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The Saint Paul Legislative Code requires that no building shall be occupied without a Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The code also provides for the assessment of additional reinspection fees.

YOU WILL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR NOTIFYING TENANTS IF ANY OF THE FOLLOWING LIST OF DEFICIENCIES ARE THEIR RESPONSIBILITY.

#### **DEFICIENCY LIST**

- 1. Exterior garage SPLC 71.01 Provide address numbers at least three (3) inches in height. (HN-1)-Provide correct size of address numbers on garage.
- 2. Interior basement SPLC 34.11 (6), 34.34 (3) Provide service of heating facility by a licensed contractor which must include a carbon monoxide test. Submit a completed copy of the Saint Paul Fire Marshal's Existing Fuel Burning Equipment Safety Test Report to this office.

- 3. Interior basement MSFC 605.1 Repair or replace damaged electrical fixtures. This work may require a permit(s). Call DSI at (651) 266-8989. -Secure outlet boxes to the ceiling and provide covers for the outlet boxes.
- 4. Interior basement NEC 110-26 Provide and maintain a minimum of 36 inches clearance in front of all electrical panels.-Remove the wood piled in front of the electrical panel.
- 5. Interior basement SPLC 34.10 (3) 34.33(2) Provide an approved guardrail. Intermediate balustrade must not be more than 4 inches apart. Intermediate rails must be provided if the height of the platform is more than 30 inches. -Provide an approved handrail and guardrail for the stairs in the basement.
- 6. Interior basement SPLC 34.10 (7), 34.34 (6) Repair and maintain the walls in an approved manner. -Repair the wall at the top of the stairs leading to the basement leading to the basement in an approved manner.
- 7. Interior garage MSFC 605.6 Provide electrical cover plates to all outlets, switches and junction boxes where missing. -Provide cover plates for all outlets and junction boxes.
- 8. Interior kitchen SPLC 34.10 (7), 34.34 (6) Repair and maintain the walls in an approved manner. -Remove pealing paint and repaint the are at the back of the kitchen leading to the outside
- 9. Interior living room MSFC 605.1 Repair or replace damaged electrical fixtures. This work may require a permit(s). Call DSI at (651) 266-8989. -Repair the ceiling light in the entry area of the living room that is hanging by the wires.
- 10. Interior throughout MSFC 605.6 Provide electrical cover plates to all outlets, switches and junction boxes where missing. -Replace all missing electrical outlet cover plates.
- 11. Interior throughout MSFC 605.4 Discontinue use of all multi-plug adapters. Discontinue the use of multi-plug adapters throughout the entire building.
- 12. Interior upstairs SPLC 34.10 (7), 34.34 (6) Repair and maintain the walls in an approved manner. -Repair the walls and ceiling in the upstairs bedroom and contact the area building inspector (Mike Barck) (651-266-9029) to get information on building permits that may be needed.
- 13. interior upstairs MN State Statute 299F.50 Immediately provide and maintain an approved Carbon Monoxide Alarm in a location within ten (10) feet of each sleeping area. Installation shall be in accordance with manufacturers instructions. -Provide a carbon monoxide alarm and working smoke detector for the second floor bedrooms.

15. SPLC 39.02(c) - Complete and sign the smoke detector affidavit and return it to this office.
