

Sound Level Variance Application March for Babies 2014 Como Park Pavilion Ball Fields Area

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Abby Walker, Community Director for the March of Dimes, has requested a sound level variance in order to have music on an outdoor stage for the March for Babies event. The stage will be located at the Como Park Midway Picnic Pavilion Ball Field area playing music from 8:30 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. on Saturday, April 26, 2014. The Department of Safety and Inspections (DSI) will be recommending the following conditions: 1. The variance shall be for the hours of 8:30 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. on Saturday, April 26, 2014. 2. All electronically powered equipment used in conjunction with the event shall not exceed 85 dBA as measured at 50 feet from the sound source. 3. The applicant shall provide personnel and equipment to monitor sound level limits as specified in Condition #1. 4. All electronically powered equipment, PA systems, loudspeakers or similar devices shall be turned off no later than 2:00p.m. on the event date. A public hearing before the City Council on this variance request will be held on Wednesday, April 16, 2014 at 5:30p.m. in the City Council Chambers.
