

Sound Level Variance Application Twin Cities Jazz Festival 2014

Steve Heckler, Executive Director of the Twin Cities Jazz Festival has requested a sound level variance in order to provide music on an outdoor stage at Mears Park from 12:00 p.m. Noon until 10:00 p.m. on June 26, 27, 28, 2014. The Department of Safety and Inspections (DSI) recommends the following conditions: 1. The variance shall be for the hours of 12:00 p.m. Noon to 10:00 p.m. on June 26, 27, 28, 2014. 2. All electronically powered equipment used in conjunction with the event shall not exceed 85 dBA as measured at 50 feet from the sound source. 3. The applicant shall provide personnel and equipment to monitor sound level limits as specified in Condition #1. 4. All electronically powered equipment, PA systems, loudspeakers or similar devices shall be turned off no later than 10:00 p.m. on the event date. A public hearing before the City Council on this variance request will be held on Wednesday, May 7, 2014, 5:30 p.m. in the City Council Chambers.
