Dear Property Representative: ALL WORK TO BE DONE OR CERTIFICATE OF OCCUPANCY WILL BE REVOKED AND A VACATE DATE OF APRIL 31,2014 FOR OCCUPANTS.

Your building was re-inspected for the Fire Certificate of Occupancy on March 24, 2014. Approval for occupancy will be granted upon compliance with the following deficiency list. The items on the list must be corrected immediately. A reinspection will be made on April 14, 2014 at 1:30P.M.

Failure to comply may result in a criminal citation or the revocation of the Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The Saint Paul Legislative Code requires that no building be occupied without a Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The code also provides for the assessment of additional reinspection fees.

#### DEFICIENCY LIST

- 1. 2091 MSFC 605.6 Provide electrical cover plates to all outlets, switches and junction boxes where missing.
- 2. 2091 Kitchen MSFC 605.6 Provide all openings in junction boxes to be sealed.
- 3. 2093 SPLC SEC 34.15 Minimum standards for safety from fire.(1.) Flammable liquids storage. No residential structure or rooming unit shall be located within a building containing any establishment handling dispensing or storing flammable liquids with a flashpoint of less than one hundred ten (110 )degrees Fahrenheit as defined by the National Board of Fire Underwriters .-Remove all propane all charcoal lighter fluid from the house.
- 4. 2093 MSFC 605.4 Discontinue use of all multi-plug adapters.

- 5. 2093 NEC 110-26 Provide and maintain a minimum of 36 inches clearance in front of all electrical panels.
- 6. 2093 SPLC 34.10 (7), 34.34 (6) Treat all walls with mold.-Repair or replace the damaged or deteriorated wall coverings.
- 7. 2093 UMC 1346.703 Provide 30 inches clearance around all mechanical equipment.-Remove all clothes boxes and any other storage 30 inches all around all mechanical equipment
- 8. 2093 Bedroom N.E. Side SPLC 34.10 (7), 34.34 (6) Repair and maintain the floor in an approved manner.-Refinish the floor. The floor has been wet and is now coming up from the Glue and has to be repaired.
- 9. Westside basement stairway SPLC 34.10 (1) Abate and maintain the basement reasonably free from dampness and free of MOLD and mildew.
- 10. SPLC 34.11 (6), 34.34 (3) Provide service of heating facility by a licensed contractor which must include a carbon monoxide test. Submit a completed copy of the Saint Paul Fire Marshal's Existing Fuel Burning Equipment Safety Test Report to this office.
- 11. MSMC 504.6 Provide, repair or replace the dryer exhaust duct. Exhaust ducts for domestic clothes dryers shall be constructed of metal and shall have a smooth interior finish. The exhaust duct shall be a minimum nominal size of four inches (102 mm) in diameter and installed in accordance with the mechanical code. This work may require a permit(s). Call DSI at (651) 266-8989. Remove all duck tape from dryer duct and provide code compliant tape.-
