#### JOINT POWERS AGREEMENT

# Between the City of Saint Paul and Independent School District 625 for Operation of a Student Program to Promote Achievement, Fitness, and Healthy Living

This is an agreement by and between the City of Saint Paul ("City"), a Minnesota municipality, on behalf of its Police Department ("SPPD"), and Independent School District 625 ("District"), a governmental unit under Minnesota Statutes section 471.59.

**WHEREAS**, the City and the District, pursuant to the provisions of Minnesota Statutes section 471.59, are authorized to enter into an agreement to exercise jointly the governmental powers and function each has individually; and

**WHEREAS**, the City and the District, pursuant to the provisions of Minnesota Statutes section 471.64, are authorized to lease, sell, and buy materials between one another; and

WHEREAS, the District wishes to provide its students with additional resources for academic achievement and skills for healthy living, and the SPPD wishes to partner with the District to further its community outreach and engagement efforts; and

WHEREAS, the parties have reached agreement on the terms and conditions under which the SPPD and the District will jointly operate a student program to promote academic achievement, fitness, and healthy living.

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY AGREED, by and between the parties as follows:

# I. Purpose.

The SPPD, through its Police Activities League ("PAL"), and the District will partner together to establish the "PAL Fitness and Healthy Living" initiative, which will be operated out of Harding High School in Saint Paul, Minnesota. PAL Fitness and Healthy Living will provide year-round school day and after school academic and fitness programming. Participants will have the opportunity to earn a varsity letter. The PAL Fitness and Healthy Living initiative will also include an update to the Tim Jones Memorial Fitness Center located within Harding High School.

## II. Costs.

#### a. Tim Jones Memorial Fitness Center:

Updates to the Tim Jones Memorial Fitness Center will be accomplished through the work of volunteers and District and SPPD staff assigned to PAL Fitness and Healthy Living. All expenses, including expenses for materials and equipment, will be funded through in-kind contributions from the District and the City, grants, or other funding sources.

# b. <u>City In-kind Contributions:</u>

- i. One or more police officers to work onsite during day and afterschool programming to mentor, motivate, and connect with participants.
- ii. Use of SPPD PAL van for student transportation to be used by SPPD personnel.

# c. <u>District In-kind Contributions:</u>

- i. One or more licensed teachers.
- ii. One or more certified athletic trainers.
- iii. District staff will identify potential participants, assess each student and enroll all program participants in PAL Fitness and Healthy Living.
- iv. District staff will develop an individual wellness plan for each participant. The wellness plan will include both fitness and academic components.
- v. The District will monitor participants on a daily basis and will conduct monthly assessments of participant achievement. The District will compile and maintain monitoring and assessment data to evaluate student performance and program quality.
- vi. Use of Harding High School gym, fields, pool, cafeteria, and locker rooms.

# III. Liability.

Nothing in this Agreement shall constitute a waiver of the rights, privileges, and benefits that each party is entitled to under Minnesota Statutes. Each party agrees that it will be responsible for its own acts and/or omissions and those of its officials, employees, representatives, and agents in carrying out the terms of this Agreement and the results thereof, to the extent authorized by law and shall not be responsible for the acts and/or omissions of the other party and the results thereof. The liability and the monetary limits of liability of the parties, their officials, employees, representatives and agents shall be governed by Minnesota Torts Claim Act, Minnesota Statutes Chapter 466, et seq., Minnesota Statutes § 471.59, and other applicable law.

## IV. Performance.

Both parties accept full responsibility for performance of the duties outlined herein, but neither the City nor the District shall be held responsible for non-performance of its duties or responsibilities under this Agreement if the party's performance was prevented by acts or events beyond the party's reasonable control, including but not limited to: severe weather and storms, earthquake or other natural occurrences, strikes and other labor unrest, power failures, electrical power surges or current fluctuations, nuclear or other civil or military emergencies, or acts of legislative, judicial, executive, or administrative authorities. Additionally, each assigned police officer will remain under the City's direction and control and will be subject to police emergency recalls for service, activation of any Tactical Alert throughout the City, and/or as officer necessities arise elsewhere in the City. Emergency recall/tactical alert/officer necessity decisions are within the City's discretion and are not subject to question or liability under this Agreement.

#### V. Data Practices

Nothing in this Agreement can be construed to be contrary to Minnesota Statutes, Chapter 13, Minnesota Government Data Practices Act, and in particular Minnesota Statutes sections 13.05, subdivisions 6 and 11, and 13.37, subdivision 1(b). All of the data created, collected, received, stored, used, maintained, or disseminated by the parties in performing functions under the Agreement is subject to the requirements of Minnesota Government Data Practices Act and all parties must comply with those requirements. If any provision in this Agreement is in conflict with the Minnesota Government Data Practices Act, the Act will control.

#### VI. Audit

Until the expiration of six (6) years after the termination of this Agreement, each party will, upon written request of the other party, make available to the requesting party, the State Auditor or the requesting party's ultimate funding sources, a copy of this Agreement and the books, documents, records and accounting procedures and practices relating to this Agreement. Both parties will comply with and address audit findings.

### VII. Term/Termination

# A. <u>Term</u>

This Agreement will be effective upon final execution by both parties until December 31, 2014. Thereafter, this Agreement will automatically renew for up to four additional one-year periods unless either party gives the other party written notice of its intent not to renew by November 1 of the then-current term. The term of this Agreement, including all renewals, shall not exceed 5 years.

# B. Termination

Either party may terminate this agreement at any time, with or without cause, upon 30 days' written notice to the other party

# C. <u>Distribution of Assets and Property.</u>

Upon expiration, dissolution, or other termination of this Agreement, all property used to support PAL Fitness and Healthy Living will be returned to the party that initially loaned or otherwise provided the property.

# VIII. Assignment

Neither party to this Agreement may assign, delegate or transfer any rights or obligations under this Agreement without prior written consent from the other party.

# IX. Amendments

Any amendment or modification to this Agreement must be in writing and will not be effective until executed by both parties.

# X. Interpretation of Agreement; Venue

This Agreement will be interpreted and construed according to the laws of the State of Minnesota. All litigation regarding this Agreement must be venued in the appropriate state or federal district court in Ramsey County, Minnesota.

# XI. Severability

The provisions of this Agreement are severable, and if any provision hereof or the application of any such provision under any circumstances is held to be invalid, such invalidity will not affect any other provision of this Agreement or the application of any other provision.

#### XII. Waiver.

Any failure of a party to assert any right under this Agreement shall not constitute a waiver or a termination of that right, this Agreement, or any provisions of this Agreement.

# Tim Jones Memorial Fitness Center

The Saint Paul Police Activities League (PAL) looks forward to partnering with Harding High School in a new and innovative program. Harding High School will allow PAL as part of their school curriculum in a course that would be called "PAL Fitness and Healthy Living."

The focal point of this program will be the Tim Jones Memorial Fitness Center. The weight room is currently outdated. Officer Jones was a proud Humboldt graduate. PAL and the Harding staff will give the weight room a cosmetic face-lift inside and outside of the building. This will be accomplished through volunteer work by PAL staff, Harding staff and any other officers or volunteers interested in helping out.

The second part of this plan is to replace the outdated and broken equipment. The new equipment would include an image of Officer Jones' badge and bear his name. When the project is completed there will be a meaningful tribute that will attract youth from all over the city to interact and bond with Saint Paul police officers.

Here are the highlights and goals of the partnership:

- Teachers and fitness instructor will assess each student and enroll each participate in PAL.
- An individual "Personal Wellness Plan" will be developed which will include an academic component.
- Staff will identify students that will benefit from this program and place them in the PAL Fitness Course. Those not in the classes will be placed in the same program after school and will include non-Harding students.
- Staff will monitor PAL kids daily and assess them monthly to accumulate data to evaluate student performance and the program quality.
- Program will include community leaders/role models and police officers to speak and motivate PAL members as part of the program.
- The program would include a daily academic component as well as a varsity lettering program in which PAL members can earn a varsity letter.
- The summer program would run all day and include recruiting younger middle school aged youth to introduce and recruit them to the PAL program.

Attached estimate to update gym facility – \$52,000

Additional costs are in-kind by the school district and police department:

Staff \$125,000

Facilities (pool, track, fields, gym, locker room and shower, cafeteria) \$100,000 In-kind police department:

Sergeant \$120,000

Officer \$101,000

Funds Raised to date -- \$28,800 – the Police Foundation has committed to raise additional funds for the initiative.
