The Department of Safety and Inspections (DSI) recommends the following conditions: 1) Variance will be for the hours of 2:00 p.m. to 11:59 p.m. on Saturday, June 14, 2014. 2) All electronically powered equipment used in conjunction with the live music event must not exceed 90 dBA as measured 50 feet from sound source or at the sound mix, whichever is the closest. 3) The applicant will provide personnel and equipment to ensure compliance with the sound level variance conditions. 4) All electronically powered equipment, PA systems, loudspeakers or similar devices will be turned off no later than 11:59 p.m. on Saturday, June 14, 2014.
