**Event:** Little Mekong Night Market

**Description of Variance** 

Location: Little Mekong Market, 394 University Avenue West

**Noise Source:** The Asian Economic Development Association, has applied for a sound level variance in order to present various activities such as amplified music, performances, poetry, and announcements, on an outdoor stage, located at the Little Mekong Night Market at 394 University Ave West The Department of Safety and Inspections (DSI) recommends the following conditions: 1) The variance will be for the Little Mekong Night Market at 394 University Ave West from 5:00 p.m. to 10:00 p.m. on Saturday, June 14<sup>th</sup>, July 5<sup>th</sup>, July 26<sup>th</sup>, August 16<sup>th</sup> and September 6<sup>th</sup>, 2014. 2) All electronically powered equipment, PA systems, loudspeakers or similar devices used in conjunction with the event must not exceed 85 dBA as measured 50 feet from the stage or sound source. 3) The applicant will provide personnel and equipment to ensure compliance with the sound level variance conditions. 4) All electronically powered equipment, PA systems, loudspeakers or similar devices must be turned off no later than 10:00 p.m. on the dates of the event. 5) The Asian Economic Development Association must maintain a copy of the approved sound level variance at the event location and have it available for review by the City of Saint Paul Police or inspection personnel.
