Your building was inspected on May 1, 2014.

The building was found to be unsafe, unfit for human habitation, a public nuisance, a hazard to the public welfare or otherwise dangerous to human life. A Condemnation Placard has been posted on the building.

The following deficiency list must be completed or the building vacated by the re-inspection date.

A reinspection will be made on May 12, 2014 at 9:30A.M..

CONDEMNATION OF THE BUILDING REVOKES THE CERTIFICATE OF OCCUPANCY.

Failure to complete the corrections may result in a criminal citation. The Saint Paul Legislative Code requires that no building be occupied without a Fire Certificate of Occupancy.

- 1. Access to all locked rooms SPLC 34.19 Provide access to the inspector to all areas of the building.
- 2. All landings MSFC 1028.3 Remove the materials that cause an exit obstruction. Maintain a clear and unobstructed exitway.-Remove all storage from all landings

- 3. All bedrooms MSFC 1026.1 Provide and maintain an approved escape window from each sleeping room or area, or discontinue use of area as a sleeping room. This work may require permit(s). Call DSI at (651) 266-8989.-Remove all storage that is blocking emergency exiting
- 4. Basment stairway MSFC 1028.3 Remove the materials that cause an exit obstruction. Maintain a clear and unobstructed exitway.-There are clothes pilled on the basement stairway that prevent entrance to the basement. remove immediately all these items
- 5. Front steps and steps attached to garage SPLC 34.09 (2) 34.32 (2) Provide an approved guardrail with intermediate ballustrade or rails 4 inches or less apart. This work may require a permit(s). Call DSI at (651) 266-9090.
- 6. House MN Stat 299F.18 Immediately remove and discontinue excessive accumulation of combustible materials.-Reduce by 80%
- 7. House SPLC 34.10 (5), 34.33 (4), 34.16 Provide and maintain interior in a clean and sanitary condition.-There are dirty clothes cog feces dishes pilled up not clean dog feces all throughout house.
- 8. House SPLC 34.14 Provide and maintain light and ventilation in all habitable rooms in accordance with the Saint Paul Legislative Code.
- 9. House MN Stat. 299F.362 Immediately provide and maintain a smoke detector located outside each sleeping area.
- 10. House MN State Statute 299F.50 Immediately provide and maintain an approved Carbon Monoxide Alarm in a location within ten (10) feet of each sleeping area. Installation shall be in accordance with manufacturers instructions.-Place all CO detectors 10 feet from each sleeping room.
- 11. Various locations MSFC 605.5 Discontinue use of extension cords used in lieu of permanent wiring.
- 12. SPLC 34.09 (3), 34.32 (3) Repair and maintain the window lock.
- 13. SPLC 34.09 (3), 34.33 (3) -Provide or repair and maintain the window screens.
- 14. SPLC 200.02 (a) No person shall own, harbor, keep or maintain in the City and dog over three months of age without a license. Provide written documentation of current license to the Fire Inspector. To obtain a dog license, contact DSI at 651-266-8989
- 15. SPLC 34.11 (6), 34.34 (3) Provide service of heating facility by a licensed contractor which must include a carbon monoxide test. Submit a completed copy of the Saint Paul Fire Marshal's Existing Fuel Burning Equipment Safety Test Report to this office.
- 16. SPLC 39.02(c) Complete and sign the smoke detector affidavit and return it to this office.
