B) On July 19, 2014, between the hours of 5:00 a.m. and 7:00 a.m. sound levels must not exceed 75 dBA at 50 feet and between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 8:00 p.m. must not exceed 85 dBA at 50 feet. 6) The applicant will provide personnel and equipment to provide continuous sound level monitoring to ensure compliance with the sound level variance conditions. 7) All electronically powered equipment, PA systems, loudspeakers, or similar devices must be turned off no later than 7:00 p.m. on July 15, 16, 17 & 18, 2014 and 8:00 p.m. on July 19, 2014.
