Your building was re-inspected for the Fire Certificate of Occupancy on April 14, 2014. Approval for occupancy will be granted upon compliance with the following deficiency list. The items on the list must be corrected immediately.

A reinspection will be made on May 16, 2014 at 11:30AM.

Failure to comply may result in a criminal citation or the revocation of the Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The Saint Paul Legislative Code requires that no building be occupied without a Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The code also provides for the assessment of additional reinspection fees.

DEFICIENCY LIST

1. Exterior - Throughout - SPLC 34.09 (1) b,c, 34.33 (1) b, c - Provide and maintain all exterior walls free from holes and deterioration. All wood exterior unprotected surfaces must be painted or protected from the elements and maintained in a professional manner free from chipped or peeling paint.
2. Exterior - SPLC 34.09 (2), 34.32(2) - Repair or replace the damaged guardrail in an approved manner. This work requires a permit. Contact DSI at (651) 266-8989. - Repair or replace exterior guardrails on all upper and lower decks.
3. Unit 1 - Kitchen - SPLC 34.10 (7), 34.34 (6) - Repair and maintain the floor in an approved manner. - Repair kitchen flooring in unit 1
4. Unit 3 - Bathroom - SPLC 34.10 (4), 34.33 (3) - Provide a bathroom floor impervious to water.

5. Unit 3 - Bathroom - SPLC 34.10 (7), 34.34 (6) - Repair and maintain the floor in an approved manner. - Repair or replace bathroom subflooring in approved manner. Obtain plumbing permit to install plumbing fixtures throughout bathroom. Contact DSI for permit (651) 266-8989.
6. Unit 4 - Throughout - SPLC 33.05 - Uncertified portions of the building must not be occupied until inspected and approved by this office. - Do not occupy unit 4 until inspected and approved by this office.
7. Exterior - SPLC 34.09 (2), 34.32(2) - Repair or replace the unsafe porch / decks or railings in an approved manner. This work requires a permit. Call DSI at (651) 266-8989.
