Noise Source: La Cucaracha Restaurante has applied for a sound level variance in order to provide outdoor music at La Cucaracha Restaurante, 36 Dale Street South on Saturday, September 13, 2014 from 12:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m. The Department of Safety and Inspections (DSI) recommends the following conditions: 1) The variance shall be for the hours of 12:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m. for a live band outdoors on Saturday, September 13, 2014. 2) All electronically powered equipment used in conjunction with the event shall not exceed 85 dBA as measured 50 feet from any sound source used for amplified music and/or announcements. 3) The applicant shall provide personnel and equipment to ensure compliance with the sound level variance conditions. 4) All electronically powered equipment, PA systems, loudspeakers or similar devices shall be turned off no later than 6:00 p.m. on Saturday, September 13, 2014.
