What is being appealed and why: (regarding summary abatement for 2228 E 6th St, 55119)

I have a chain link fence along the back of my property about 12 inches in from the alley. I have three metal garden stakes that stick out through the fence about 8 to 10 inches. I have gardens and grow vegetables, flowers, and herbs on both sides of this fence.

Aside from supporting my plants, I have these three stakes in my fence as a deterrent against having my fence pushed over by vehicles coming out of the driveway directly across the alley. Many times over the past few years my fence has been damaged and bent into my yard. After getting help from a friend to re-straighten the fence as much as we could, I put in these thin aluminum stakes hoping to deter cars and trucks from pushing my fence in.

Please see attached photos of damage to my fence.

These garden stakes do not impede normal right of way access of the alley.

I have a plastic bin which is filled with leaves and has drainage holes to keep water from accumulating. It is about 18 inches in diameter and is up tight against my fence. It probably does stick out into the alley several inches, but many of my neighbors have trash cans that are out in the alley further than this and I don't think anyone sees this as being in the alley's right of way. My neighbor directly across the alley from me, in fact, parks his car in the alley between the bin and the other neighbor's driveway. The truck is obviously much larger than the bin. Moving the bin will not increase right of way access of the alley in any way.





Appeals: You may appeal this order and obtain a hearing before the City Council by completing an appeal application with the City Clerk before the appeal deadline noted above or seven (7) days after the date mailed, whichever comes first. No appeals may be filed after that date. You may obtain an appeal application from the City Clerk's Office, Room 310, City Hall, St. Paul, MN 55102. The telephone number is (651) 266-8585. You must submit a copy of this Correction Order with your appeal application.

*WARNING Code inspection and enforcement trips cost the taxpayers money.
