NOTICE OF INTENT TO REVOKE LICENSE

Dear Mr. Still:

The Department of Safety and Inspections (DSI) has recommended revocation of all licenses held by Eden Pizza Twin Cities, LLC, d/b/a Eden Pizza for the premises located at 629 Aldine Street in Saint Paul. The basis for the recommendation is as follows:

On June 16, 2014, the Department of Safety and Inspection (DSI) received a notice from the Minnesota Department of Revenue stating that you had an overdue tax liability. Under Minnesota State Law, your licenses must be revoked until your tax delinquency is resolved and DSI receives a Clearance Certificate from the Department of Revenue.

At this time, you have two (2) options how to proceed:

- If you wish to admit the facts but contest the penalty, you may have a public hearing before the Saint Paul City
 Council, you will need to send me a letter with a statement admitting the facts and requesting a public hearing.
 We will need to receive your letter by Thursday, July 3, 2014. The matter will then be scheduled before the
 City Council for a public hearing to determine whether to revoke your licenses. You will have an opportunity
 to appear before the Council and make a statement on your own behalf.
- 2. If you dispute the facts outlined above, you may request a hearing before an Administrative Law Judge (ALJ). I will need to receive your letter no later than **Thursday**, **July 3**, **2014**. At that hearing both you and the City will appear and present witnesses, evidence and cross-examine each other's witnesses. After receipt of the ALJ's report (usually within 30 days), a public hearing will need to be scheduled. At that time, the City Council will decide whether to adopt, modify or reject the ALJ's report and recommendation.

Please note: If you choose an administrative hearing, the Department of Safety and Inspections reserves the right to request that City Council impose the costs of the administrative hearing per Saint Paul Legislative Code § 310.05 (k).

If you have not contacted me or DSI by Thursday, July 3, 2014, I will assume that you do not contest the revocation of your licenses. In that case, the matter will be placed on the City Council Consent Agenda for approval of the recommended penalty.
