NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

Sound Level Variance Epilepsy Foundation Stroll for Epilepsy at Lake Phalen Park

TO: Payne Phalen District 5 Planning Council and District 2 Community Council

This is to inform you of a request for a variance from the sound level limitations as indicated in the St. Paul Noise Ordinance (Chapter 293 of the St. Paul Legislative Code). Property owned by you and located near the noise source, may be affected by this variance request.

Rental property owners must provide a copy of this notice to all renters or post a copy in a common area of the building so it can be viewed by the occupants.

Description of Variance:

Location: Lake Phalen Park

Noise Source: The Epilepsy Foundation Stroll for Epilepsy Event, represented by Heather Hammond, Development Events and Corporate Sponsorship Manager, has requested a sound level variance in order to present outdoor music and microphone speaking at Lake Phalen Park from 4:45 p.m. until 9:00 p.m. on Thursday, August 7, 2014. The Department of Safety and Inspections (DSI) recommends the following conditions: 1. The variance shall be for the hours of 4:45 p.m. to 9:00 p.m. on Thursday, August 7, 2014. 2. All electronically powered equipment used in conjunction with the event shall not exceed 85 dBA as measured at 50 feet from the sound source. 3. The applicant shall provide personnel and equipment to monitor sound level limits as specified in Condition #2. 4. All electronically powered sound equipment, PA systems, loudspeakers or similar devices shall be turned off no later than 9:00 p.m. on the event date.
