## Revocation of Fire Certificate of Occupancy and Order to Vacate

37 WYOMING ST E

Dear Property Representative:

Your building was inspected on June 16, 2014, for the renewal of the Certificate of Occupancy. Since you have failed to comply with the applicable requirements, it has become necessary to revoke the Certificate of Occupancy in accordance with Section 40.06 of the Saint Paul Legislative Code. A reinspection will be made on July 1, 2014 at 12:00 pm or the property vacated.

The Saint Paul Legislative Code further provides that no building shall be occupied without a Certificate of Occupancy. Failure to immediately complete the following deficiency list or the building vacated may result in a criminal citation.

## DEFICIENCY LIST

- 1. Exterior Drive Way SPLC 34.08 (7) All parking spaces shall be paved with asphalt, concrete, or durable dustless surfacing. Before any existing spaces may be paved, site plan approval must be obtained as specified in the St. Paul Zoning Code. Contact DSI Zoning at 651-266-9090.-Replace parking spaces under permit.
- 2. House Eaves/Fascia SPLC 34.09 (1) b,c, 34.33 (1) b, c Provide and maintain all exterior walls free from holes and deterioration. All wood exterior unprotected surfaces must be painted or protected from the elements and maintained in a professional manner free from chipped or peeling paint.-Repair holes along all eave/fascia boards throughout.
- 3. House Roof SPLC 34.09 (1) e, 34.32 (1) d Provide and maintained the roof weather tight and free from defects.-Repair or replace curling roof shingles along roof top of house.

- 4. Interior Access Throughout SPLC 34.19 Provide access to the inspector to all areas of the building.-Failure to meet the inspector for the scheduled appointment or failure to contact the inspector to reschedule the scheduled appointment will result in enforcement action.
- 5. North Exterior Storm Door SPLC 34.09 (3), 34.33 (3) -Provide or repair and maintain the window screen.-Repair or replace damaged/curling screen on storm door.
- 6. Northeast Interior Stairwell Walls SPLC 34.10 (7), 34.34 (6) Repair and maintain the walls in an approved manner.
- -Patch the holes and/or cracks in the walls.
- 7. Northeast Interior Stairwell Walls SPLC 34.10 (3), 34.33(2) Repair or replace the damaged handrail in an approved manner.-Replace missing bottom staircase handrail. Repair loose upper staircase railing.
- 8. Northwest Exterior Shed Doors Ext. Door SPLC 34.09 (3), 34.33 (3) Repair and maintain the door in good condition.-Replace deteriorated doors on shed in northwest corner of house.
- 9. UNIT 1 South Storm Door Ext. Door SPLC 34.09 (3), 34.33 (3) Repair and maintain the door in good condition.-Replace damaged/deteriorated storm door.
- 10. UNIT 2 Bathroom SPLC 34.11, MSBC 2902.1, SPLC 34.17, MSPC 415.0220 Repair or replace and maintain all parts of the plumbing system to an operational condition. Replace or replace broken toilet.
- 11. UNIT 2 East Bedroom Closet SPLC 34.12 (2), SPLC 34.36 (1) Repair and maintain all required and supplied equipment in an operative and safe condition to properly and safely perform their intended function in accordance with the provisions of the applicable code. -Replace missing door handle on closet door.
- 12. UNIT 2 Kitchen/Bathroom SPLC 34.10 (7), 34.34 (6) Repair and maintain the ceiling in an approved manner.-Patch the holes and/or cracks in the ceilings. Paint the ceilings.
- 13. UNIT 2 South Window SPLC 34.09 (3), 34.32 (3) Repair and maintain the window glass.-Replace broken window.
- 14. UNIT 2 South Window SPLC 34.09 (3), 34.32 (3) Repair and maintain the window frame.-Replace broken exterior window frame, screen and storm window.
- 15. SPLC 34.11 (6), 34.34 (3) Provide service of heating facility by a licensed contractor which must include a carbon monoxide test. Submit a completed copy of the Saint Paul Fire Marshal's Existing Fuel Burning Equipment Safety Test Report to this office.
- 16. SPLC 39.02(c) Complete and sign the smoke detector affidavit and return it to this office.
