REVOCATION OF FIRE CERTIFICATE OF OCCUPANCY AND ORDER TO VACATE

Dear Property Representative:

An inspection was made of your building on July 30, 2014 in response to a complaint. You are hereby notified that the following deficiency list must be corrected immediately. A reinspection will be made on August 14, 2014 at 9:00am.

Saint Paul Legislative Code provides that no building shall be occupied without a Certificate of Occupancy. In order to re-occupy the building, the following deficiencies (if applicable) must be corrected and a complete Certificate of Occupancy inspection will be required.

DEFICIENCY LIST

1. MSFC 901.7 - Provide a fire watch until the fire alarm system is returned to service. -A fire watch will be required by a professional monitoring company as agreed by the occupant during all times the dwelling is over-occupied. Failure to comply with this requirement will result in the immediate vacate of the dwelling. **-Immediately provide documentation to this office.**

2. SBC 3405.1, SBC 110.2 - The occupancy group or use division of this building has been changed from that previously approved. -Single family dwelling has been converted into an illegal rooming and boarding house.

3. SPLC 62.101 - Use of this property does not conform to zoning ordinance. Discontinue unapproved use or call DSI Zoning at (651) 266-8989 to convert to legal use. **Discontinue use as an illegal rooming and boarding house.**

4. SPLC 34.11 (6), 34.34 (3) - Provide service of heating facility by a licensed contractor which must include a carbon monoxide test. Submit a completed copy of the Saint Paul Fire Marshal's Existing Fuel Burning Equipment Safety Test Report to this office.

5. SPLC 34.13 (2), (3), SPLC 34.17 (2) - Reduce and maintain the number of occupants in the unit to: 4 or less unrelated adults. 19 occupants found living in the dwelling.

6. SPLC 39.02(c) - Complete and sign the smoke detector affidavit and return it to this office.

You have the right to appeal these orders to the Legislative Hearing Officer.
