## Brief description of work and development proposed:

Placement of salvaged logs and stones in a broken wheel arrangement roughly 15 feet in diameter. This Hub will give the children and larger community a gathering place more natural than anything that currently exists at the park. It will also be looked to as an outdoor classroom for the elementary school in areas like science, art, and writing. We will use volunteer labor guided by community members with landscape design expertise and will treat the logs beforehand with marine varnish.
