Dear Ms. Johnson:

This is to confirm that our office has received your application for four Sound Level Variance applications from the city's noise ordinance and that they are being processed.

The Department of Safety and Inspections will be recommending that these variances be issued to you, with conditions, in order to present various use of mobile stages, speakers, DJ and/or Band as well as announcements at the Monster Dash 2014 Events. There are four proposed Sound Level Variance applications with locations at Start Area - Cathedral Hill Park, Summit Avenue to Start Line, 400 Feet East of Nina Street; Shepard Road, Washington to Eagle/Chestnut and Upper Landing Park for the Finish Areas; a third at Rice Park during a 5K Event, and a fourth at a 10 Mile Finish at Shepard Road between Homer and Elway. The Monster Dash Events are proposed for October 25, 2014 for various times between the hours of 7:30 a.m. to 2:30 p.m.

A public hearing on your request for a variance has been scheduled for **Wednesday**, **October 15**, **2014**, **at 5:30 p.m.**, Third Floor, City Council Chambers, at the Saint Paul City Hall/Ramsey County Courthouse, 15 Kellogg Boulevard W., Saint Paul, Minnesota.

You may wish to be present at this hearing to answer any questions that the City Council might have. After the public hearing, the Council may grant, deny, or modify the variance request.
