## To whom it may concern:

We have been working closely with Fire Inspector Sebastian Migdal to bring our recently renovated apartments up to date with fire codes. Attached are the list of corrections/ deficiencies that he has requested we complete. We are in the process of completing each one.

However, we wish to appeal number 4 "UPPER LEVEL DOORS LEADING TO TENANT SPACES - FIRE DOORS". The doors that are currently in place are original to the building. They are in above average condition considering their age (nearly 90 years). Removing these doors to replace with 20 minute fire-rated doors would be an aesthetic abomination, considering we renovated the original apartments back to their original splendor. The doors match the existing millwork, have been in place since the building was built, and to fabricate doors that comply with a 20 minute rating would be extremely cost prohibitive. We would be pleased to place door closers on the existing doors in order to comply with that portion of the request.

Please consider our appeal. We are good landlords who care about our community and our tenants. We have "A" ratings on all of our properties, and we have worked diligently to comply with the remainder of the fire C of O regulations.

Dear Property Representative:

Your building was re-inspected for the Fire Certificate of Occupancy on September 8, 2014. Approval for occupancy will be granted upon compliance with the following deficiency list. The items on the list must be corrected immediately. A reinspection will be made on October 9, 2014 at 10:00 AM.

Failure to comply may result in a criminal citation or the revocation of the Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The Saint Paul Legislative Code requires that no building be occupied without a Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The code also provides for the assessment of additional reinspection fees.

## **DEFICIENCY LIST**

- MAIN LEVEL-UNOCCUPIED SPACE THAT IS UNDER CONSTRUCTION SPLC 33.05 - Uncertified portions of the building must not be occupied until inspected and approved by this office.
  - -All open permits will have to be finaled prior to occupying this space. Contact inspector prior to occupying this space.
- 2. OPEN PERMITS MSFC 105.1.1 Permits required. Permits required by this code shall be obtained from the fire code official. Permit fees, if any, shall be paid prior to issuance of the permit. Issued permits shall be kept on the premises designated therein at all times and shall be readily available for inspection by the fire code official.
  - -There is an open building permit for the residential space. Contact the building inspector Todd Sutter and have the permit finaled prior to the reinspection.

- 3. UPPER LEVEL COMMON HALLWAY-SIDE STAIRWELL-REAR STAIRWELL FIRE SEPERATION MSFC 703 Repair and maintain the required fire resistive construction with approved materials and methods. This work may require a permit(s). Call DSI at (651) 266-9090.
  - -Provide proper fire separation (1 hour rating) between the side stairwell and the rear stairwell (where the window is presently located).
- 4. UPPER LEVEL-DOORS LEADING TO THE TENANT SPACES FIRE DOORS MSFC 703 Provide, repair or replace the fire rated door and assembly. The minimum rating must be: 20 Minutes
  - -Provide fire doors where needed. The fire doors must be equipped with door closers.
- 5. UPPER LEVEL-UNIT 1 DEADBOLT LOCK MSFC 1003.3.1.8 Remove unapproved locks from the exit doors. The door must be openable from the inside without the use of keys or special knowledge or effort.
  - -Remove the additional dead bolt lock as discussed during the reinspeciton.

You have the right to appeal these orders to the Legislative Hearing Officer.
