The public notice sent to me to consider the ratification of assessments for light rail transit on University Ave. to the benefited property Owners. No one has shown or convinced me that the property owners will or have benefit from these added extras to light rail.

Over three years ago You approved these extras and you were going to try to find the money to pay for them elsewhere. I noticed that less than a quarter of the amount was found but it is not only the money in question but the fairness of who is being taxed for these extras.
