Dear Property Representative:

Your building was inspected on September 15, 2014 for the renewal of your Fire Certificate of Occupancy. Approval for occupancy will be granted upon compliance with the following deficiency list. The items on the list must be corrected prior to the re-inspection date.

A re-inspection will be made on October 15, 2014 at 1:45 pm.

Failure to comply may result in a criminal citation or the revocation of the Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The Saint Paul Legislative Code requires that no building shall be occupied without a Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The code also provides for the assessment of additional reinspection fees.

YOU WILL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR NOTIFYING TENANTS IF ANY OF THE FOLLOWING LIST OF DEFICIENCIES ARE THEIR RESPONSIBILITY.

DEFICIENCY LIST

- 1. Basement Electrical Boxes SPLC 34.12 (2), SPLC 34.36 (1) Repair and maintain all required and supplied equipment in an operative and safe condition to properly and safely perform their intended function in accordance with the provisions of the applicable code.

 -Missing unit numbers on electrical panels in basement.
- 2. Basement South Room MSFC 605.1- All light fixtures shall be maintained with protective globes if originally equipped.-Missing light cover.

- 3. Exterior Multiple Areas SPLC 34.08 (1), 34.31 (1) All exterior property areas shall be maintained free from any accumulation of refuse, garbage or feces.-Remove all trash and trash bags from the property.
- 4. Exterior Northeast Side SPLC 34.08(5), 34.32(3) All accessory structures including, but not limited to, detached garages, sheds and fences shall be maintained structurally sound and in good repair. Provide and maintain exterior unprotected surfaces painted or protected from the elements.-Cut back all over grown tree limbs.
- 5. Exterior Storm Doors North and South 2nd Floor SPLC 34.09 (3), 34.32 (3) Repair and maintain the door latch.-Remove taped door latch on north side and replace broken storm door handle on south 2nd floor.
- 6. Lower Unit Southwest Bedroom SPLC 34.10 (7), 34.34 (6) Repair and maintain the ceiling in an approved manner.-Repair or replace damaged ceiling.
- 7. Lower Unit Southwest Bedroom SPLC 34.13 (1) Provide and maintain all habitable areas with a ceiling height of 7 feet over 1/2 the floor area.

-Southwest Bedroom Measurements:

 $98 \times 108 = 73.5 \text{ sq. ft.}$

6'9" ceiling height in bedroom (Bedroom has flat ceiling).

- 8. South Entry East Wall MSFC 315.2.5 Fueled equipment, including but not limited to motorcycles, mopeds, lawn-care equipment and portable cooking equipment, shall not be stored, operator or repaired within a building.-Remove lighter fluid containers and store outside of house.
- 9. South Exterior Parking Lot SPLC 34.08 (7) All parking spaces shall be paved with asphalt, concrete, or durable dustless surfacing. Before any existing spaces may be paved, site plan approval must be obtained as specified in the St. Paul Zoning Code. Contact DSI Zoning at 651-266-9090.-Repair or replace deteriorated drive way under permit.
- 10. South Exterior Pole Outlets MSFC 605.6 Provide electrical cover plates to all outlets, switches and junction boxes were missing.-Tighten loose exterior outlet weather cover. Install missing middle pole outlet covers.
- 11. South Exterior Shed SPLC 71.01 Provide address numbers on shed.-Missing address numbers on shed facing the alley.
- 12. Upper Unit Exterminator Report SPLC 34.10 (6), 34.33 (5) Exterminate and control insects, rodents or other pests. Provide documentation of extermination.-Have a license contractor treat unit for roaches.

- 13. Upper Unit Kitchen Sink SPLC 34.10 (7), 34.33 (6) Repair and maintain the cabinets in an approved manner.-Replace damaged floorboard underneath kitchen sink.
- 14. SPLC 34.11 (6), 34.34 (3) Provide service of heating facility by a licensed contractor which must include a carbon monoxide test. Submit a completed copy of the Saint Paul Fire Marshal's Existing Fuel Burning Equipment Safety Test Report to this office.
- 15. SPLC 39.02(c) Complete and sign the smoke detector affidavit and return it to this office.
