NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

Sound Level Variance Red Bull Crashed Ice 2015 - International Ice Cross

TO: Summit-University Planning Council and CapitolRiver Council District 17

This is to inform you of a request for a variance from the sound level limitations as indicated in the St. Paul Noise Ordinance (Chapter 293 of the St. Paul Legislative Code). Property owned by you and located near the noise source, may be affected by this variance request.

Rental property owners must provide a copy of this notice to all renters or post a copy in a common area of the building so it can be viewed by the occupants.

Description of Variance:

Location: Event will be located along John Ireland Boulevard, in or near North Cathedral Hill Park, Monument Park, Cathedral Hill Park, South Cathedral Hill Park and Arch Park.

Noise Source: Hangman Productions, Inc. has applied for a sound level variance in order to allow 24/7 operation of chillers and generators beginning Friday, December 26, 2014 through Friday, February 6, 2015 and the use of an amplified sound system for the Red Bull Crashed Ice event, to be held on Wednesday, January 21, 2015 through Saturday, January 24, 2015 between 4:00 PM and 10:00 PM. Applicant has indicated that chillers and generators used for the event will not exceed 80 decibels at 15 feet and speakers will not exceed 95 decibels at 80 feet.
