Your building was found to be unsafe, unfit for human habitation, a public nuisance, a hazard to the public welfare or otherwise dangerous to human life. A Vacate Order has been posted on the building.

The following deficiency list must be completed and the building must remain vacant until inspected and approved by this office.

A reinspection will be made on or after September 29, 2014.

CONDEMNATION OF THE BUILDING REVOKES THE CERTIFICATE OF OCCUPANCY.

Failure to complete the corrections may result in a criminal citation. The Saint Paul Legislative Code requires that no building be occupied without a Fire Certificate of Occupancy.

DEFICIENCY LIST

1. SPLC 34.11 (6), 34.34 (3) - Provide service of heating facility by a licensed contractor which must include a carbon monoxide test. Submit a completed copy of the Saint Paul Fire Marshal's Existing Fuel Burning Equipment Safety Test Report to this office.

2. SPLC 39.02(c) - Complete and sign the smoke detector affidavit and return it to this office.

3. SPLC 34.23, MSFC 110.1 - This occupancy is condemned as unfit for human habitation. This occupancy must not be used until re-inspected and approved by this office. -Dwelling is condemned per Code Enforcement orders. Building is lacking basic facilities (electric) and has multiple code violations.
