NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING 2015 Red Bull Crashed Ice Village Sound Level Variance Request

Dear Property Owner:

This is to inform you of a request for a variance from the sound level limitations as indicated in the St. Paul Noise Ordinance (Chapter 293 of the St. Paul Legislative Code). Property owned by you and located near the noise source, may be affected by this variance request. Rental property owners must provide a copy of this notice to all renters or post a copy in a common area of the building so it can be viewed by the occupants.

Description of Variance:

Location: 7th Street West between Chestnut and Walnut Streets for DJ truck and DJ with music in tent in parking lot of Burger Moe's, 242 7th Street West

Noise Source: Visit Saint Paul Festival has requested a sound level variance to use a DJ truck with speakers as well as a DJ with music in a tent on 7th Street West between Chestnut and Walnut Streets and in a tent in the parking lot of Burger Moe's, 242 7th Street West for the 2015 Red Bull Crashed Ice Village. The variance shall be for the hours of 5:00 p.m. to 11:00 p.m. on Saturday, January 24, 2015. The Department of Safety and Inspections (DSI) recommends the following conditions: 1) The variance shall be for the hours of 5:00 p.m. to 11:00 p.m. on Saturday, January 24, 2015. 2) All electronically powered equipment used in conjunction with the event shall not exceed 95 dBA as measured 80 feet from the sound source. 3) The applicant shall provide personnel and equipment to conduct continuous sound level monitoring during the event. 4) All electronically powered sound equipment, PA systems, loudspeakers or similar devices shall be turned off no later than 11:00 p.m. on the event date.
