An inspection was made of your building on December 8, 2014 in response to a referral. You are hereby notified that the following deficiency list must be corrected immediately.

A re-inspection will be made on January 8, 2015 at 11:00am.

Failure to comply may result in a criminal citation or revocation of the Certificate of Occupancy. The Saint Paul Legislative Code requires that no building shall be occupied without a Certificate of Occupancy. The code also provides for the assessment of additional re-inspection fees.

DEFICIENCY LIST

- 1. Unit 1 - Bathroom - SPLC 34.10 (4), 34.33 (3) - Provide a bathroom floor impervious to water.-Repair the Bathroom in a professional manner and permits maybe required.
- 2. Unit 1 - Hallway bedrooms - SPLC 34.12 (2), SPLC 34.36 (1) - Repair and maintain all required and supplied equipment in an operative and safe condition to properly and safely perform their intended function in accordance with the provisions of the applicable code. Repair the door knobs in both bedrooms in the main hallway.
- Unit 1 Living Room SPLC 34.10 (5), 34.33 (4), 34.16 Provide and maintain interior in a 3. clean and sanitary condition. Clean the furnace vent in the living Room.
- 4. Unit 1 - Main Hallway - MN State Statute 299F.50 Immediately provide and maintain an approved Carbon Monoxide Alarm in a location within ten (10) feet of each sleeping area. Installation shall be in accordance with manufacturer's instructions.

- 5. Unit 1 Throughout SPLC 34.12 (2), SPLC 34.36 (1) Repair and maintain all required and supplied equipment in an operative and safe condition to properly and safely perform their intended function in accordance with the provisions of the applicable code. Repair or replace the smoke detectors.
- 6. Unit 1 West bedroom SPLC 34.12 (2), SPLC 34.36 (1) Repair and maintain all required and supplied equipment in an operative and safe condition to properly and safely perform their intended function in accordance with the provisions of the applicable code. Replace the bedroom door.
- 7. Unit 1 North Bedroom SPLC 34.12 (2), SPLC 34.36 (1) Repair and maintain all required and supplied equipment in an operative and safe condition to properly and safely perform their intended function in accordance with the provisions of the applicable code. Repair the bedroom door in an approved manner it is not hung on both hinges.

It is the responsibility of the owner to notify the tenants at least 24 hours in advance that an inspection will be done. Please have keys available to all units and common areas.

Saint Paul Legislative Code authorizes this inspection and the collection of inspection fees. It is a criminal misdemeanor violation should you not permit this inspection by failing to appear for this appointment without rescheduling with the inspector. In addition, a No Entry Fee of \$60.00 may be assessed to the Renewal Fee whenever the owner or responsible representative needs to re-schedule the appointment but fails to notify the inspector, in writing, by 8:00 a.m. on the date of the inspection.

If you no longer own this building, contact the inspector immediately between 7:30 - 9:00 a.m., Monday through Friday.

FOR CONDOS:

The interior of owner-occupied dwelling units are exempt from this inspection. In condominium buildings, only rental units, the common areas, and utility area will be inspected.

FOR APARTMENTS AND DWELLINGS:
