## NOTICE OF VIOLATION

Khaled Aloul, President Midway Amoco BP 1347 University Avenue West Saint Paul, MN 55104-4002

Cigarette/Tobacco license held by Midway University & Hamline, LLC d/b/a Midway Amoco BP for the premises located at 1347 University Avenue West in Saint Paul License ID #20100000243

Dear Khaled Aloul:

The Department of Safety and Inspections (DSI) has recommended adverse action against the Cigarette/Tobacco license held by Midway University & Hamline, LLC d/b/a Midway Amoco BP for the premises located at 1347 University Avenue West in Saint Paul. The basis for the recommendation is as follows:

On December 29, 2014, a tobacco compliance check was conducted at Midway Amoco BP located at 1347 University Avenue West. A sixteen year old female entered your establishment and asked to buy tobacco products. She was not asked to show her identification, which would have indicated she was underage. Nevertheless, the clerk sold her a Swisher Sweet cigar. Sale of tobacco to an underage person is a violation of Minn. Stat. § 609.685 and Saint Paul Legislative Code § 324.07(c).

This is the first (1<sup>st</sup>) violation for the sale of cigarettes to an underage person; therefore, per Saint Paul Legislative Code §324.11 (b) (1) the licensing office will recommend a \$200.00 matrix penalty.

At this time you have four (4) options to proceed:

1. If you do not contest the imposition of the proposed adverse action, you may do nothing. If I have not heard from you by **Monday, January 19, 2015**, I will presume that you have chosen not to contest the proposed adverse action, and the matter will be placed on the City Council Agenda for approval of the proposed remedy.

- 2. You can pay the \$200.00 matrix penalty. If this is your choice, you should make payment directly to the Department of Safety and Inspections, at 375 Jackson Street, Ste. 220, St. Paul, Minnesota 55101-1806 no later than **Monday, January 19, 2015**. A self-addressed envelope is enclosed for your convenience. Payment of the \$200.00 matrix penalty will be considered to be a waiver of the hearing to which you are entitled.
- 3. If you wish to admit the facts but you contest the penalty, you may have a public hearing before the Saint Paul City Council. You will need to send me a letter with a statement admitting to the facts and requesting a public hearing. I will need to receive your letter no later than **Monday**, **January 19, 2015.** The matter will then be scheduled before the City Council for a public hearing to determine whether to impose the \$200.00 matrix penalty. You will have an opportunity to appear before the Council and make a statement on your own behalf.
- 4. If you <u>dispute the facts</u> outlined above, you may request a hearing before an Administrative Law Judge (ALJ). You will need to send me a letter disputing the facts and requesting an administrative hearing by **Monday**, **January 19**, **2015**. At that hearing both you and the City will appear and present witnesses, evidence and cross-examine each other's witnesses. After receipt of the ALJ's report (usually within 30 days), a public hearing will need to be scheduled. At that time, the City Council will decide whether to adopt, modify or reject the ALJ's report and recommendation.

Please note: If you choose an administrative hearing, the Department of Safety and Inspections reserves the Right to request that City Council impose the costs of the administrative hearing per Saint Paul Legislative Code § 310.05 (k).

If you have not contacted me or DSI by Monday, January 19, 2015, I will assume that you are not contesting the imposition of the \$200.00 matrix penalty. In that case, the matter will be placed on the City Council Consent Agenda for approval of the recommended penalty.

Please be advised that the clerk who was identified as having made the sale on this date is also being charged a \$50.00 administrative penalty pursuant to Minn. Stat. §461.12, subd. 3. This is a separate action from this license matter.
