Dear Property Representative:

Your building was re-inspected for the Fire Certificate of Occupancy on December 29, 2014. Approval for occupancy will be granted upon compliance with the following deficiency list. The items on the list must be corrected immediately. A reinspection will be made on or after January 28, 2015.

Failure to comply may result in a criminal citation or the revocation of the Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The Saint Paul Legislative Code requires that no building be occupied without a Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The code also provides for the assessment of additional reinspection fees.

DEFICIENCY LIST

- 1. Library space MSFC 1010.1, 1003.2.10 Provide and maintain approved directional exit signs.-
- 2. Library space MSFC 1005.2 Provide an approved additional means of egress due to an inadequate number of exits. All work to install exits must be done by a licensed contractor under permit.-This occupancy is condemned for inadequate exiting. Provide plans for approval for installation of 2 more exit out of the space. All work must be done under permit. Space must not be occupied or used until approved emergency exits are install to code.

- 3. Library space MSFC Table 1010.17.2 Provide an approved additional means of egress to reduce the travel distance to the exit.-This occupancy is condemned for inadequate exiting. Provide plans for approval for installation of 2 more exit out of the space. All work must be done under permit. Space must not be occupied or used until approved emergency exits are install to code.
- 4. Library space SPLC 34.23, MSFC 110.1 This occupancy is condemned as unsafe or dangerous. This occupancy must not be used until re-inspected and approved by this office.-This occupancy is condemned for inadequate exiting. Provide plans for approval for installation of 2 more exit out of the space. All work must be done under permit. Space must not be occupied or used until approved emergency exits are install to code.
- 5. Library space MSFC 703 Provide and maintain fire rated floor and/or ceiling construction with approved materials and methods. This work will require a permit(s). Call DSI at (651) 266-9090. The minimum rating must be: required occupancy separations.
- 6. Library space MSFC 703 Repair and maintain the required fire resistive construction with approved materials and methods. This work may require a permit(s). Call DSI at (651) 266-9090.-
