Location: 33 7th Place West

Noise Source: Wild Tymes has requested a sound level variance to present amplified music in a three sided tent with use of a sound system for St Patrick's Day Events on Saturday, March 14, 2015 and on Tuesday, March 17, 2015 at 33 7th Place West. The variance is requested for the hours of 4:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. on Saturday, March 14, 2015, and from 2:00 p.m. until 8:00 p.m. on Tuesday, March 17, 2015.

The Department of Safety and Inspections will be recommending the following conditions: 1) The variance shall be for the hours of 4:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. for the St Patrick's Day Events on Saturday, March 14, 2015, and from 2:00 p.m. until 8:00 p.m. on Tuesday, March 17, 2015. 2) All electronically powered equipment used in conjunction with the event shall not exceed 85 dBA as measured at 50 feet from the sound source. 3) The applicant shall provide personnel and equipment to ensure compliance with the sound level variance conditions. 4) All electronically powered equipment, PA systems, loudspeakers or similar devices shall be turned off no later than 8:00 p.m. on March 14, 2015 and March 17, 2015.
