NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

Sound Level Variance Request – March 13 and 14, 2015 O'Bennetts Saint Patrick's Day Weekend

Dear Property Owner:

This is to inform you of a request for a variance from the sound level limitations as indicated in the St. Paul Noise Ordinance (Chapter 293 of the St. Paul Legislative Code). Property owned by you and located near the noise source, may be affected by this variance request. Rental property owners must provide a copy of this notice to all renters or post a copy in a common area of the building so it can be viewed by the occupants.

Description of Variance:

Location: 1305 7th Street West for live music in an enclosed tent at Bennett Restaurant Co. LLC Noise Source: Bennett Restaurant Co. LLC has requested a sound level variance to present live music in an enclosed tent at 1305 7th Street West, for the 2015 O'Bennetts St Patrick's Day Weekend. The variance shall be for the hours of 5:00 p.m. to 10:30 p.m. on Friday, March 13, 2015 and Saturday, March 14, 2015. The Department of Safety and Inspections (DSI) recommends the following conditions: 1) The variance shall be for the hours of 5:00 p.m. to 10:30 p.m. on Friday, March 13, 2015 and Saturday, March 14, 2015. 2) All electronically powered equipment used in conjunction with the event shall not exceed 90 dBA as measured inside the tent at the wall opposite from the sound source. 3) The applicant shall provide personnel and equipment to conduct continuous sound level monitoring during the event. 4) All electronically powered sound equipment, PA systems, loudspeakers or similar devices shall be turned off no later than 10:30 p.m. on the event dates.
